Call for a Post Doctoral position 02/2016 PNPD grant / CAPES - National Postdoctoral Program

The Faculty of the Graduate Studies and Research in Animal Diversity Program (PPGDA) of the Federal University of Bahia (UFBA) is selecting one (1) candidate to act as a Fellow of the National Post Doctoral Program (PNPD), from CAPES, Brazil, with duration of 24 months. CAPES is a Foundation within the Ministry of Education in Brazil whose central purpose is to coordinate efforts to improve the quality of Brazil's faculty and staff in higher education through grant programs.

The applicant must have a Zoology-oriented academic profile to work in one of the scientific lines of the Program: (1) Systematics and Biogeography and / or (2) Biology and Behavior (see *Apresentação/Linhas* in <http://www.diversidadeanimal.bio.ufba.br>), being highly productive in the last four years in order to accomplish the requirements to be a member of the permanent faculty of the PPGDA (see criteria at <http://www.diversidadeanimal.bio.ufba.br/Legislacao.html>). The selected candidate has to work associated to at least one of the PPGDA professors (see <http://www.diversidadeanimal.bio.ufba.br/Docentes.html>).

The candidates are asked to send to ppgzoo@ufba.br their curriculum and letter of intents, with a maximum of 7 pages (font-size 12, line spacing 1.5), which must include: (1) applicant's research line, (2) brief description of research project, (3) professor or professors of the PPGDA with whom he/she plans to associate, (4) how the professor and the pos-doc will associate to produce scientific papers, derived from the research performed in UFBA, (5) infrastructure (material, services and equipment) required to develop the project, (6) plans to obtain grants and resources to develop the project and (7) proposal of projects for future Master and PhD students and disciplines.

October, 17 2016 - deadline to submit the documentation

October, 26 2016 - disclosure of the selected candidate

November 2016 – expected time to start the activities.
